

GYPSUM DRYWALL

SCOPE

Contractor certified as having knowledge in the area of, and be limited to the installation of gypsum drywall products to existing studs, joists or suspended ceiling channels; the fabrication and installation of all necessary and incidental metal accessories, including non-load bearing metal studs, runners, hangers, channels, drywall metal suspension accessories and prefabricated ceiling materials; and the preparation and finish of the drywall surface. This includes the application of base and finish coats specifically designed for the gypsum drywall products. This category shall not include plastering, block or wood partitions. Contractor also certified in the area of all business and finance knowledge/skills associated therewith.
