Contractor certified as having knowledge in the area of, and be limited to, erecting, attaching, applying and embedding tile in concrete, clay or other material, applied to floors or walls, and shall include the application of base courses. Scope of work shall include tile, pavers, brick or similar materials. This work is to include non-load-bearing structural elements. Contractor also certified in the area of all business and finance knowledge/skills associated therewith.
